

Queen Anne's County is rated as the safest county to live, work and play on the Eastern Shore! Crime statistics report an overall downward trend in crime based on data from 15 years. Based on this trend, the crime rate in Queen Anne's County in 2023 is expected to be lower than in 2019 -- the crime rate was lower than the national violent crime rate average by 78.4%. Property crime rates were lower than the statewide crime rate by 89.9%. The #1 complaint in our county is speeding. Easiest way to avoid speeding is to know your local speed limits and obey the law. 
