Phishing

In the last several days the queenslanding.org email address was hacked and several of you received a bogus email asking you to click a link saying "Office Shared a File with you". DO NOT OPEN THAT FILE - it is a phishing attack. We believe we have re-secured the email account to prevent future issues. As a good practice, never click on an attachment that is not clearly defined. (Phishing is a type of cyberattack where attackers deceive individuals into revealing sensitive information like passwords, credit card details, or personal data, often through fraudulent emails, text messages, or websites.)
